**Treasurer's Report:** The primary agenda item was to review the detailed budget for the 2023-2024 church year. Carol Plumlee led the discussion and fielded the questions from the Board members. The budget had been previously reviewed and approved by the Finance Committee. Carol reported that, as of this date, pledges for the upcoming year are at 88% of target. **The Board voted to approve the proposed budget for the 2023-2024 church year.** 

**President's Report:** Holly Anderson discussed the agenda for the upcoming Annual Fiscal Meeting on May 21. The vote on the budget will be preceded by slides explaining the major take-aways from the proposed budget and will include a vote to increase the 4% distribution from the endowment fund to 5% for the upcoming year. Meagan Pittluck-Schmitt will present the report of the Endowment Committee. The Board discussed the vote for the 8th Principle with the majority agreeing that the vote should occur and, if the 8th Principle is approved, be seen as only the beginning of conversations and commitment to action regarding antiracism.

**Vice-President's Report:** Mark reported that the Ministerial Evaluation will be shared with Rev. Scott in the near future.

**Minister's Report:** Rev. Scott discussed his schedule for his final months at UUCR. His sermon topic for May 21 will be Journey Toward Wholeness."

The Meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm. The next Board meeting will be May 25 on Zoom.
