Our goal is to provide you with a fun-filled evening and raise a sizable amount of money for our church. We encourage everyone to stay the entire evening-until the final item has been auctioned off, and the party and auction have been declared satisfyingly successful!

Please note the following:

- Items will not be auctioned off in the order that they appear in this booklet.
- Silent auction offerings will be awarded to the highest bidders. In the event of ties, the item/event/service will be awarded to the person who first bid the highest amount.
- If live-auction items are offered more than once (such as a service), they will be auctioned once to set the going price. After that, losing bidders are free to sign up at that price, subject to availability.

UUCR Auction Etiquette

For the hosts of social events:

- At least two weeks before your event, mail or e-mail an invitation/reminder to your guests.
- Please stick to your original date as advertised in the auction whenever possible. If you absolutely must change the date of the event, let your guests know as far in advance as you can and, if possible, give guests a choice of alternative dates.
- Please schedule all activities and events to take place before the date of the next auction.

For the guests at social events:

- Note the date of the auction event on your calendar and keep it free.
- When you receive an invitation/reminder, please respond to your host and let them know if you will be able to attend.
- If you cannot attend, you may find a substitute to take your place. If you find a substitute, give your host their name, phone number, address, and e-mail. Make sure your substitute knows the time and place of the event.
- If you can't or don't want to find a substitute, please let your host know as soon as possible. There are often new members who have joined the church after the auction and didn't have the opportunity to bid on auction events.
- Please don't cancel at the very last minute unless it is a dire emergency. Your host has been preparing for a certain number of guests and a last minute cancellation means last minute confusion and extra work, especially if it is a sit-down dinner. Please don't ask to bring additional guests, as most events are already planned for a fixed number of guests.
- Remember-winning bids are a promise to pay and become the obligation of the winning bidder(s).
